FIRST HOLY COMMUNION


First Holy Communion for SSK School will be on Saturday, May 5 at 10 a.m.

MISSION LUNCH

In an effort to help our SSK School students learn about the realities of world hunger, many of them will volunteer to participate in a Mission Lunch on Wednesday, April 17. During this event, children will donate the money they would have spent for lunch that day. In place of their usual lunch, students will eat only rice and water as many less fortunate people do every day.

Our students will also choose to go without a snack on this day and will donate their snack money to the less fortunate. Through this sacrifice, the students will further develop empathy for children around the world who experience hunger on a daily basis. Additionally, they will raise funds to help save children's lives, changing futures across the world.

ST. JUDE MATH-A-THON

Our school has been participating for many years in raising money for St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. Thanks to programs like the St. Jude Math-A-Thon and the supporters of this program, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital is leading the way the world understands, treats and defeats childhood cancer and other life-threatening diseases. For the last two years, the SSK School religion club has planned a school kick-off event that included a play last year and a pep rally this year.

This event gathers the school children together to learn about the St. Jude Math-A-Thon and the importance of helping the children of St. Jude by solving math problems and collecting donations. Last year SSK School raised \$4,600 and we hope to meet our goal of \$5,000 this year. The students of our school are doing math and helping to save lives.
